Rules Inside the building

Corridor rules:

In order to maintain safety and an orderly atmosphere, students are to conduct themselves respectfully in the school corridors and stairwells whenever changing classes, and leaving or entering the classroom areas. Students are to be observant regarding the people things around them, therefore, students are not to run in the corridors, yell or scream, or act in ways which would constitute possible hurt to themselves or others.

Cafeteria rules:

MIS provides lunch for all students during the scheduled lunch break. We expect all students to eat during their lunch time. The food may be brought from home or purchased from the school. If bringing food from home, please supply healthy food items. Do not bring chewing gum, lollipops, candy, junk food, fizzy drinks, or other unhealthy items to school. Lunches are to be eaten in the cafeteria only.

Cafeteria etiquette includes:

- Being polite to other students, teachers and cafeteria staff;
- Using the courteous words: "please" and "thank you";
- Talking in a calm, subdued tone; no yelling or screaming is acceptable;
- Cleaning up after oneself (putting trays, dishes and eating utensils in their proper places) and pushing the chair back under the table;
- Respecting food and not throwing it away uneaten.
